Harvesting Goodness Galatians 6:7-10

We learn to accept responsibility for our actions, even when we are powerless over our lives. We come to realize that all our actions yield consequences. Some of us may have fooled ourselves into thinking we can escape the consequences of the things we've done. But with time, it has become clear that God has made accountability a necessary element of healthy living.

"You will always harvest what you plant! Those who live only to satisfy their own sinful nature will harvest decay and death from that sinful nature. But those who live to please the Spirit will harvest everlasting life from the Spirit" (Galatians 6:7-8).

The law of planting and harvesting can also work for us. God spoke through the prophet Hosea: "Plant the good seeds of righteousness, and you will harvest a crop of love. Plow up the hard ground of your hearts, for now is the time to seek the LORD, that he may come and shower righteousness upon you" (Hosea 10:12).

God says we always harvest what we have planted. Even after we have been forgiven, we must deal with the consequences of our actions. It may take time to finish harvesting the negative consequences from our past, but we don't have to let this discourage us. Making our list of those we have harmed is a step toward planting good seeds. In time we will see a good crop begin to grow.

Sowing and Reaping

Galatians 6:7-10

Paul left an important reminder for us all. We will always reap what we have sown. In other words, sins have painful consequences. For a while we might be able to fool ourselves into thinking that certain activities and relationships are all right. But when the consequences catch up with us, there will be no denying the facts. We need to take this warning seriously and take steps to change now. We don't have to wait to hit bottom before we act. Using God's Word as our standard, we can take a fearless moral inventory and work toward living a godly life before it's too late.

Unending Love Hosea 11:8-11

We need to admit to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs. We may be sorely aware of the deep shame, trouble, and pain we inflicted on our family when we were controlled by our addictions. We may be afraid to admit the exact nature of our wrongs because we don't understand how God could love someone who is so bad.

We may be asking, How could God (or anyone) still love me? But God asks, "Oh, how can I give you up . . .? How can I let you go? How can I destroy you . . .? My heart is torn within me, and my compassion overflows....For I am God and not a mere mortal. I am the Holy One living among you, and I will not come to destroy" (Hosea 11:8-9). There is absolutely nothing we can do or confess to God that would cause him to stop loving us (see Romans 8:38-39).

Just For Today the Choice is Mine

Just for today I will try to be happy, realizing my happiness does not depend on what others do or say or what happens around me. Happiness is a result of being at peace with myself.


