Accountability

Bible Reading: Jude 1:20-23

As we grapple with our sins, we are likely to avoid honest communication with others about our problems. It is important, however, that we return to the relationships that will help us face the truth. Paul spoke of the value of honesty: "So stop telling lies. Let us tell our neighbors the truth, for we are all parts of the same body" (Ephesians 4:25). Jude, the brother of Jesus, reminded his readers that they were to deal honestly and directly with those who were doing wrong: "Show mercy to those whose faith is wavering. Show mercy to still others, but do so with great caution, hating the sins that contaminate their lives" (Jude 1:22-23).

Accountability and honesty in our relationships are essential to spiritual growth. When we make ourselves accountable to others, the caring influence of godly friends can help keep us on the right track. They can provide us with an objective perspective, helping us to admit the truth. We often become isolated as a result of our shame or fear that we will be rejected if we ever reveal who we really are. Admitting our wrongs to trustworthy people helps break down the isolation.

Stand Firm with God's Help

Jude 1:17-23 - God's Word is reliable and true. It warns us about people who might try to hinder our spiritual growth. When we learn to expect such people, we can prepare to stand firm against the temptations they bring us. By learning to recognize our weaknesses, walking humbly, and depending on the Holy Spirit's guidance, we can shun the things that tear us down. When we encourage others, the story we tell must be clear and consistent with our lifestyle. We can share God's message of hope by showing others the kind of selfless love that God has already shown to us. We cannot live this way under our own power; we can do it only by receiving the power God offers through his Holy Spirit.

Avoid Temptations

Jude 1:14-16 - Jude reminded his readers that the false teachers among them would suffer terrible consequences for their selfish and sinful lifestyle. We may be tempted to follow our old friends back into the "pleasures" of sinful habits. Jude's warning can help us turn away from any such temptations. If we take part in destructive activities, we will be enslaved and then destroyed. If we plant seeds of righteousness by following God's will, we will receive God's blessings and help. True freedom can be found only through a vibrant relationship with God.

Just for Today the Choice is Mine

Just for today I will do somebody a good turn and not get found out. If anyone knows of it, it will not count. I will do at least one thing I don't want to do, and I will perform some small act of lover for my neighbor.


